

## Investors in Pupils timeline

**1999** Cath Paul, Deputy Head of Royal Park Primary, Leeds creates the standard

**2000** Pilot – funded by Leeds Training and Enterprise Council and later revised by TEC, later Learning And Skills Council

**2006** LSC passes the standard to the 5 West Yorkshire LA's to run as a Partnership (managed centrally by Leeds)

**2007** Investors in Pupils website created

**2007** First Secondary school achieves the standard

**2008** First school outside of West Yorkshire achieves the standard.

**March 2009** Central coordination of the standard moves to Bradford.


**April 2009** Promotional DVD created

**September 2009** Website updated to include online registration


**July 2010** First Open Event run outside of West Yorkshire

**July 2012** First Welsh school achieves the standard (bringing total number of LA's where at least one school is accredited to 33)

**August 2013** Central Business Unit established and hosted by Leeds City Council



**November 2013** First school in Northern Ireland achieves Investors in Pupils, over 50 Local Authorities now have an Investors in Pupils school



**September 2014** A new website is launched for assessors, schools and franchise area users. @InvestinPupils twitter account reaches 100 followers
